Music Outreach

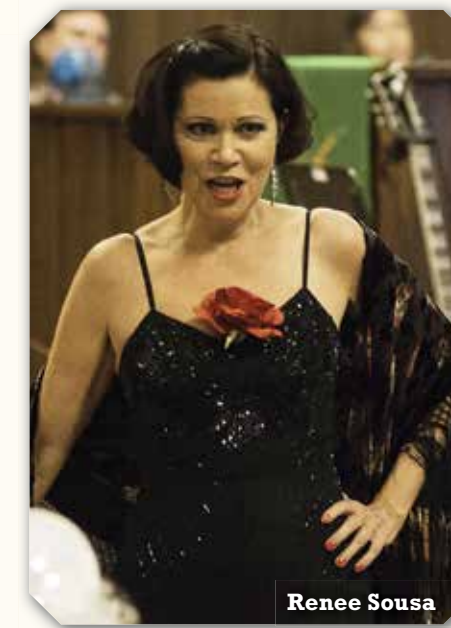
Not content with just producing concerts, the POPS is committed to expanding its influence by making a meaningful difference in the lives of children.
